

Torgerson named one of top three scholarship recipients in the state

TORREY — Morgan Torgerson was awarded an additional \$5,000 scholarship from the EnergySolutions Foundation at an awards banquet April 27.

Torgerson, who was the recipient of a \$2,000 scholarship from the foundation in March, was selected from more than 700 students from 118 high schools throughout the state.
